**Credential cards** are issued for either Qualification or NCCER Basic Rigger students who successfully complete the course and tests. Qualification cards are valid for up to two years, as long as the individual maintains compliance to Standards and Regulations. NCCER certifications are recognized world-wide and are credentials that may be maintained and accessed for life.

#### Program Options and Fees

Programs include experienced instructors, student materials, equipment and site fees. Test options and fees are determined by student/employer selection of:

- Basic Rigger Skill Training with Signalperson & Qualification testing written and practical examination, \$550 per person OR
- Basic Rigger Skill Training with NCCER accredited certification testing, written and practical examinations, \$1,199 per person OR
- For company-dedicated classes, 1 to 8 students, \$1950 per day, includes qualification testing;
  - To add NCCER accredited testing to company-dedicated classes, add \$450 per person for written and practical examinations
  - An additional half day may be necessary to complete NCCER testing, depending on the number of students and their familiarity with proper rigging techniques
